

The Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Minnesota BECA Scholarship Application

HCCM is a well-managed, national award-winning-nonprofit community and economic development organization that provides training, technical assistance, workforce development, homeownership counseling, financial literacy and other resources to Latino individuals and entrepreneurs. It is managed by 10 unpaid, all professional Latino Board of Directors and presently has over 300 members. We are affiliate members of US Hispanic Chamber, the National Council of La Raza, the MN Council of Nonprofits, the Better Business Bureau, MN Dept. of Revenue, and have many other state, regional and local resource partners. We have a MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) with the SBA (Small Business Administration) to increase the number of loans to Latino's. The HCCM is serviced by over seventy-seven volunteers that manage our five (5) Program Areas; among the best known is the "Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Minnesota". We were incorporated in July of 2000, and opened our Minneapolis office in October of that year.

Latinos in Minnesota come from many countries other than Mexico, they include Guatemala, El Salvador, Colombia, Venezuela, Ecuador, Peru, Bolivia, Chile, Argentina, Uruguay, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Panama, Puerto Rico, Cuba, and the Dominican Republic. Of the more than 36 million person of Hispanic/Latino heritage that live in the United States just over 215,000 people make the state of Minnesota their home. In the West North Central sector of the Midwest region, only Kansas has a larger Latino population than Minnesota.

Today, Latinos comprise the largest ethnic minority group in Minnesota, positioning it among the top ten states nationally in terms of Hispanic population growth and sixth in the nation for fastest growing economically and in buying power.

PURPOSE

Through the HCCM BECA Scholarship Program, our organization provides mentoring, networking and financial assistance to students committed to serving the Hispanic/Latino community, including students of Hispanic origin. HCCM will grant scholarships in the amount up to \$1,000.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Completed applications must be postmarked or received no later than September 1st.
2. All applicants must have graduated from a U.S. High School or GED/HSED program
3. All applicants must be Minnesota residents.
4. All applicants must have at least 50% Hispanic/Latino ancestry.
5. Provide proof of enrollment as a full-time Junior or Senior student at a recognized/credentialed Minnesota higher education institution for the academic year for which financial aid is being sought.
6. Application materials will not be returned to applicant after submission.
