

# Policy background: **College Debt**

**With 9,900 students earning a bachelor's degree each year at our 18 private nonprofit institutions...**

## 32%

32 percent of our graduates have no debt.

---

## 66%

66 percent of our graduates have less than \$26,000 in debt. (\$26,000 is the median amount of debt for graduates with debt.)

---

## 1%

1 percent of our students who borrow default on their debt—compared to the Minnesota average of 1.6 percent and the national average of 2.3 percent.

---



## \$3,508

The median monthly earnings for our graduates working in Minnesota two years after graduation is \$3,508.

---

## <9%

The median monthly loan payment for our graduates with debt is \$290, which is 8.3 percent of the median monthly earnings.
