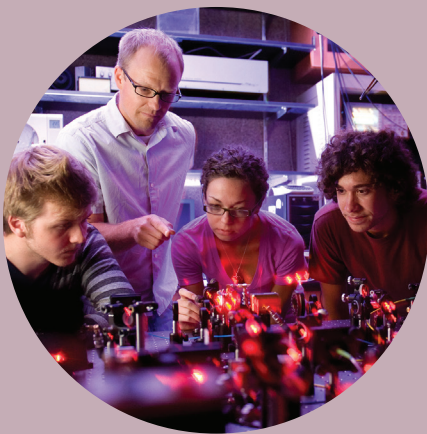


# Policy background: **Outcomes & Workforce**

## #1 and #5

Our colleges' graduation rate ranks first in Minnesota and the Midwest—and fifth in the nation. That means our students start their careers sooner.

---

## \$76,800

The median earnings of our alumni working full-time in Minnesota four years after graduation is \$76,800.

---

## \$1.15 million

The average return on investment for undergraduate students at our colleges is \$1.15 million; this takes into account both education costs and 40 years of future earnings.

---

## 70%

70 percent of our recent graduates stay in Minnesota, strengthening the workforce and tax base.

---

## 350,000

Our 350,000 alumni living in Minnesota contribute to the vitality of their communities.
