## Group visit guidelines

*Our colleges want your visits to go as smoothly as possible for both you and your students. Please keep the following in mind.*

### Chaperone expectations

If you are planning to bring a large group, please be aware that our colleges require 1 adult chaperone for every 10 students. Chaperones need to accompany and supervise students at all times during the visit; campus staff are not responsible for this. If inappropriate student behavior occurs, chaperones are expected take corrective actions to remedy it.

### Grades level restrictions

Minnesota Private College week is intended for students who will be seniors, juniors, sophomores or freshmen in the upcoming fall. We ask that you do not bring students who will not be in these grades.

### Other advice

- Let us know prior to your visit if anyone in your group needs special accommodations.
- Encourage students to wear comfortable clothing and shoes since part of the visit will include walking outside.

- Plan to arrive at least 20 minutes early to allow enough time for parking and check-in.
